Malaysian Certificate in Legal Practice (CLP) Examination

In general, University of London graduates and all graduates from recognized overseas universities who wish to become lawyers can sit for CLP examination. The CLP study takes about a year. After passing the CLP exam, the graduate will have to undergo a 9 – month apprenticeship known as chambering or pupillage before he or she can be admitted to the Malaysian Bar as an advocate and solicitor. The 5 subjects are General Paper, Professional Practice, Evidence, Criminal Procedure, and Civil Procedure.

Entry Requirement for CLP (for University of London Programme graduates)

- 1) 2 passes at A-Level (or STPM) + 3 Credits in SPM or 2B's in UEC + 3 Credits in SPM. (All A-Level Passes and SPM Credits. Must be obtained in one and same sitting of the examination respectively. The A-Level shall be studied in a minimum of 1 academic year).
- 2) Complete the LLB degree within 7 years upon successful completion of the Intermediate (i.e. the first 4 units) exam.
- 3) Take 12 law units which must include the following 6 core-unites: Law of Contract, Law of Tort, Constitutional Law, Criminal law, Land Law, and Equity & Trusts.
- 4) Must obtain at least a Second Class Lower.
